NOTES ON A CONVERSATION WITH MIKE NORDIN, MANAGER PACIFIC CONSERVATION DISTRICT

I had a conversation with Mike Nordin on September 4 about the next steps to take to eradicate the noxious weeds in Loomis Lake. Here is a summary of the conversation:

- 1. He is willing and eager to be the lead agency in this effort, as recommended by the Pacific County Commissioners.
- 2. He is compiling a collection of all material from the last decade and a half on this project, going back to the main 1998 document. He will collect all of this material and get it to us for reading,
- 3. Then we can all meet and move forward and be on the same page.
- 4. We should meet the week of September 22 to discuss how to update the last plan, and to plan a public meeting, probably in October with a facilitator.

NEXT MEETING:

Mike said that he and his staff are willing to come to the Peninsula for a meeting, and the Sunset Sands Club House is a good location for them. He suggested inviting all Working Group members plus any lake front property owners that we have contacted up to this point.
