Minutes of the 2016 annual meeting were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was presented and approved. Regular Account Beginning Balance: \$6123.84

Regular Account Ending Balance: \$10,599.92

Reserve Account Beginning Balance: \$7,035.80

Reserve Account Ending Balance: \$7,039.31

Architectural Committee:

3 new fences were approved to be installed.

2 new homes were approved.

1 new garage was approved,

2 repaints were approved. New repaints are only required to be approved if a new color is used.

1 new deck was approved.

A proposal to enclose a carport was approved.

A request to relocate a walkthrough door on the side of a garage was approved. 1

new shed was approved.

Year in Review:

1. The work on the drainage problem along 194th will begin now that we've had our annual meeting.
2. Part of the cement area at the BBQ site has been removed.
3. Signs prohibiting fireworks have been posted in both sections of the subdivision.
4. Ed Strange is in charge of park maintenance. He has worked on the bathrooms and done some painting.

Community input:

1. It was noted the speed limit sign is blocked and needs attention. Ed will be asked to trim the bushes.
